SUMMARY


Staff is requesting approval of the resolution in support of participation in the 2016/2017 NMDOT Local Government Road Fund (LGRF) Program which provides funds to local entities for pavement rehabilitation and improvements.

BACKGROUND

The BCC approved Resolution NO. 2016-77, at the July 12, 2016, BCC meeting to participate in the LGRF Program SP Funding for the pavement rehabilitation/improvements for various County Roads in Santa Fe County, New Mexico. The resolution contained minor errors that need to be corrected through a new resolution. Santa Fe County is required to provide 25% in matching funds in the amount of \$22,637.00 with the State's share of 75% in the amount of \$67,910.00 for a total project cost of \$90,547.00
