BACK ROUND:

Resolution 2016 : A Resolution Authorizing the County Manager To Sign and

Submit Application for Federal Grant To Implement the Accountable Health Communities Model, including All Related Agreements (Community Services

Department/Patricia Boies)

Issue: Authorization of County Manager to approve and sign Accountable Health Communities grant-related Memoranda of Agreement (MOAs), application, and post-award materials on behalf of Santa Fe County in order for timely compliance with application and funding requirements.

Background: On February 8, 2016, the Board of County Commissioners for Santa Fe County found to be well taken staff recommendations for the Santa Fe County Community Services Department to apply for a Centers for Medicare Medicaid Services Accountable Health Communities (AHC) grant. In order to meet the March 31, 2016 deadline for the AHC grant submission and for timely compliance with grantor requirements should Santa Fe County be awarded the grant, the County Manager must be authorized to approve and sign required application and post-award documents such as MOAs.

Recommendation: We recommend passage of the resolution designating authority to the Santa Fe County Manager to approve and sign AHC application-related documents and to negotiate and execute post-application MOAs, agreements, and documents.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SANTA FE COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2016 -

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MANAGER TO SIGN AND SUBMIT APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL GRANT TO IMPLEMENT THE ACCOUNTABLE HEALTH COMMUNITIES MODEL, INCLUDING ALL RELATED AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, in order to improve the health of the community, the Santa Fe Board of County Commissioners has long supported efforts to increase care coordination and navigation of Santa Fe County residents to address important health-related social needs such as reduction in interpersonal violence and access to transportation, housing, and healthy food; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe County Health Policy and Planning Commission working with the Santa Fe County Community Services Department has prioritized goals in the Santa Fe County Health Action Plan which have at their center effective navigation and care coordination by area health care and community based service providers; and

WHEREAS, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services ("CMS") published Funding Announcement Opporunity ("FAO") Number CMS-1P1-17-001 to implement and test the Accountable Health Communities ("AHC") Model; and

WHEREAS, the AHC Model is an innovative model with three tracks that is based on the theory that funding interventions to connect those on Medicaid and Medicare with community services will fill a critical gap in the current health-care delivery system and reduce costs; and

WHEREAS, Track 3 (up to \$4,510,000) incorporates screenings and navigation and requires award recipients to partner with community service providers to align services, funding streams, and data systems, and to facilitate coordinated delivery of services; and

WHEREAS, to be considered for funding to test the AHC Model, an application ("Application") must be submitted by March 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, staff has recommended that Santa Fe County submit the Application to CMS as part of a consortium with Los Alamos County, Rio Arriba County, and Taos

County, with Santa Fe County serving as the Bridge Organization, to implement and test the AHC Model within the geographic target area encompassed by the four counties; and

WHEREAS, the Application must include memorandums of agreement ("MOAs") or the equivalent with partnering counties, a State Medicaid Agency, clinical delivery sites (e.g., hospitals), and community service providers (e.g., affordable housing providers) within the geographic target area; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners for the County of Santa Fe finds staff's recommendations to be well-taken; and

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County has submitted a Letter of Intent to file an Application to CMS; and

WHEREAS, in order to meet the deadline of March 31 to file the Application, the County Manager should be authorized to review, approve, and sign the Application and all related materials.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Manager is authorized to approve and sign the Application on behalf of Santa Fe County and to negotiate and execute all MOAs, agreements, and any other post-award related documents in order to timely comply with all application and funding requirements.
