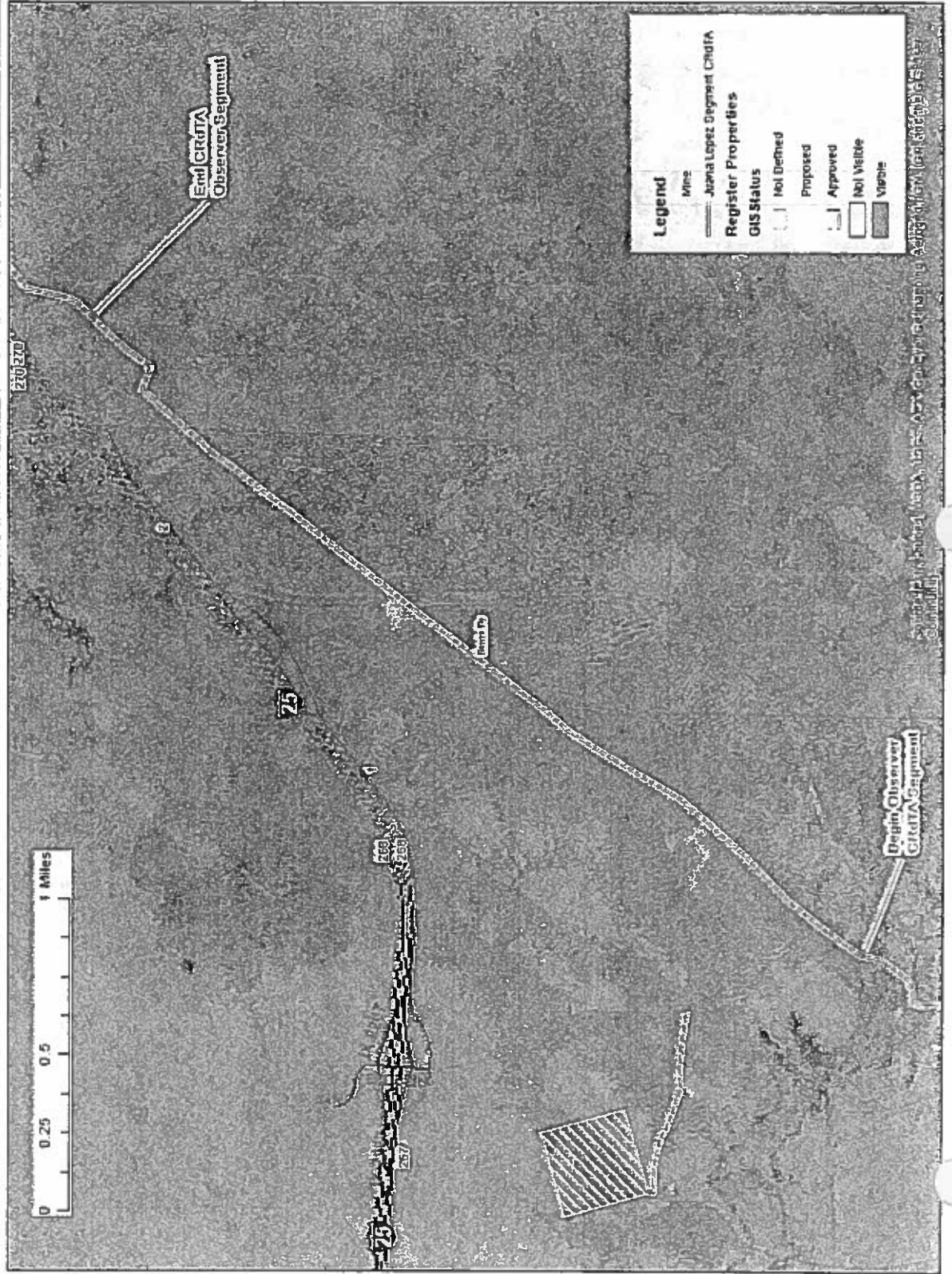

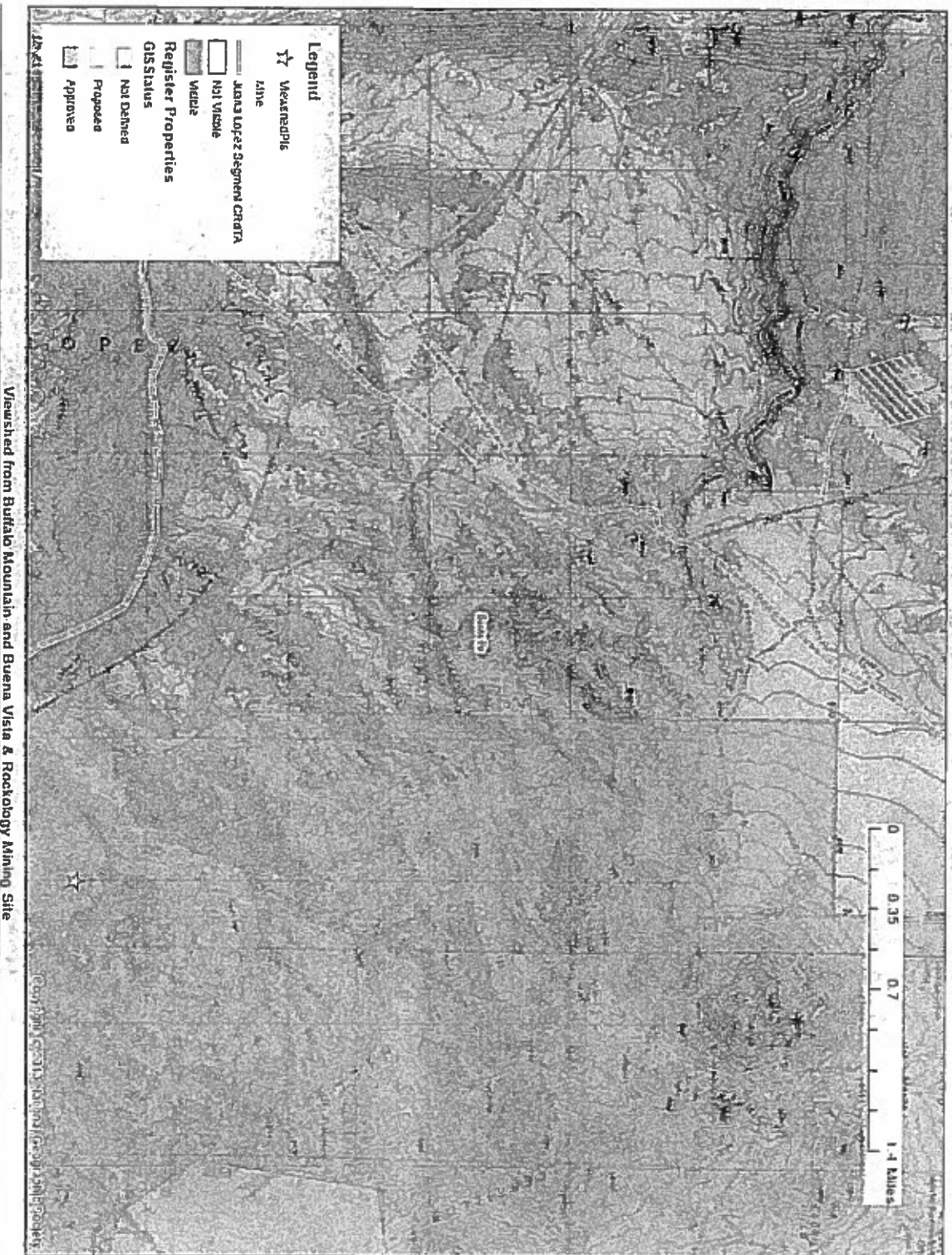

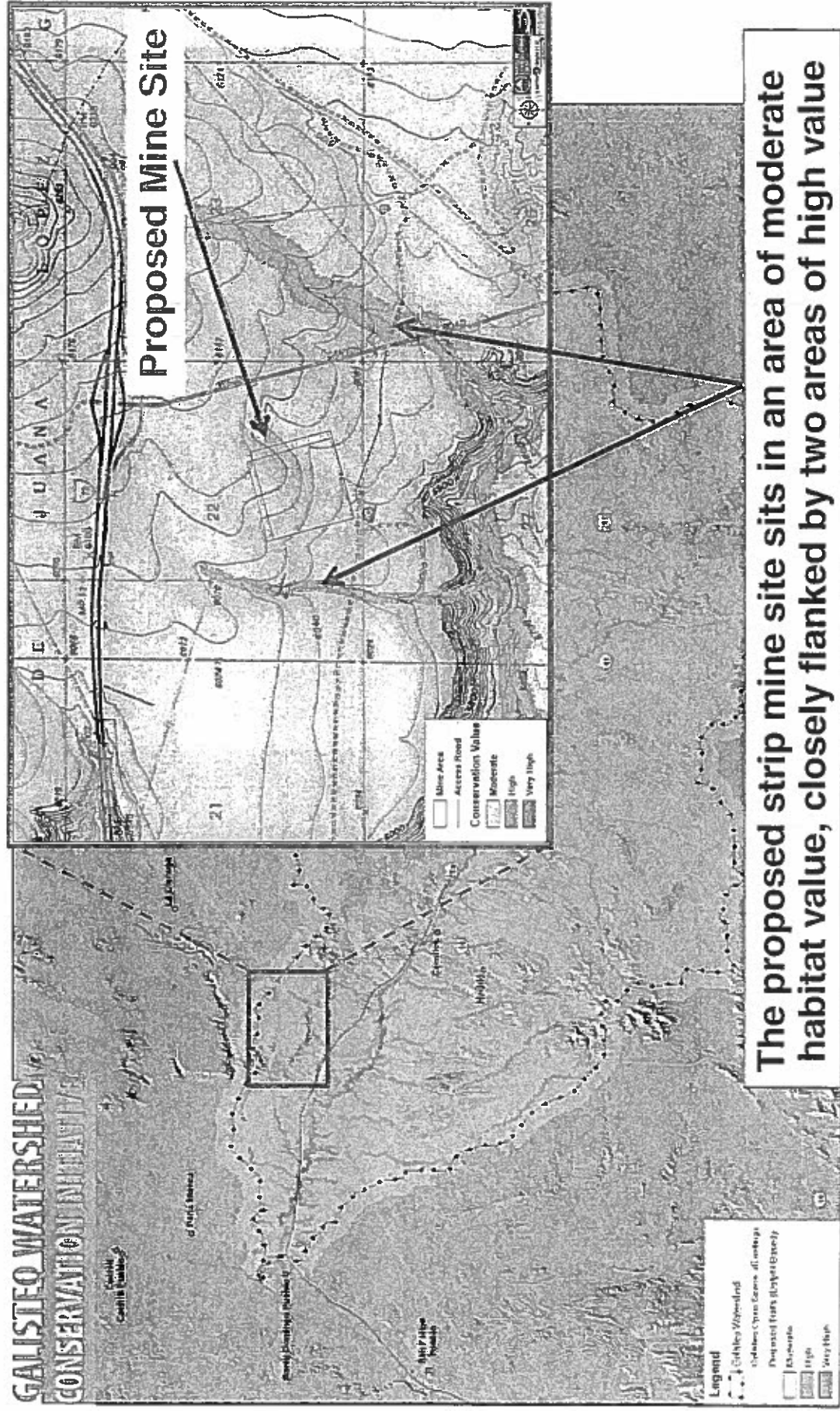

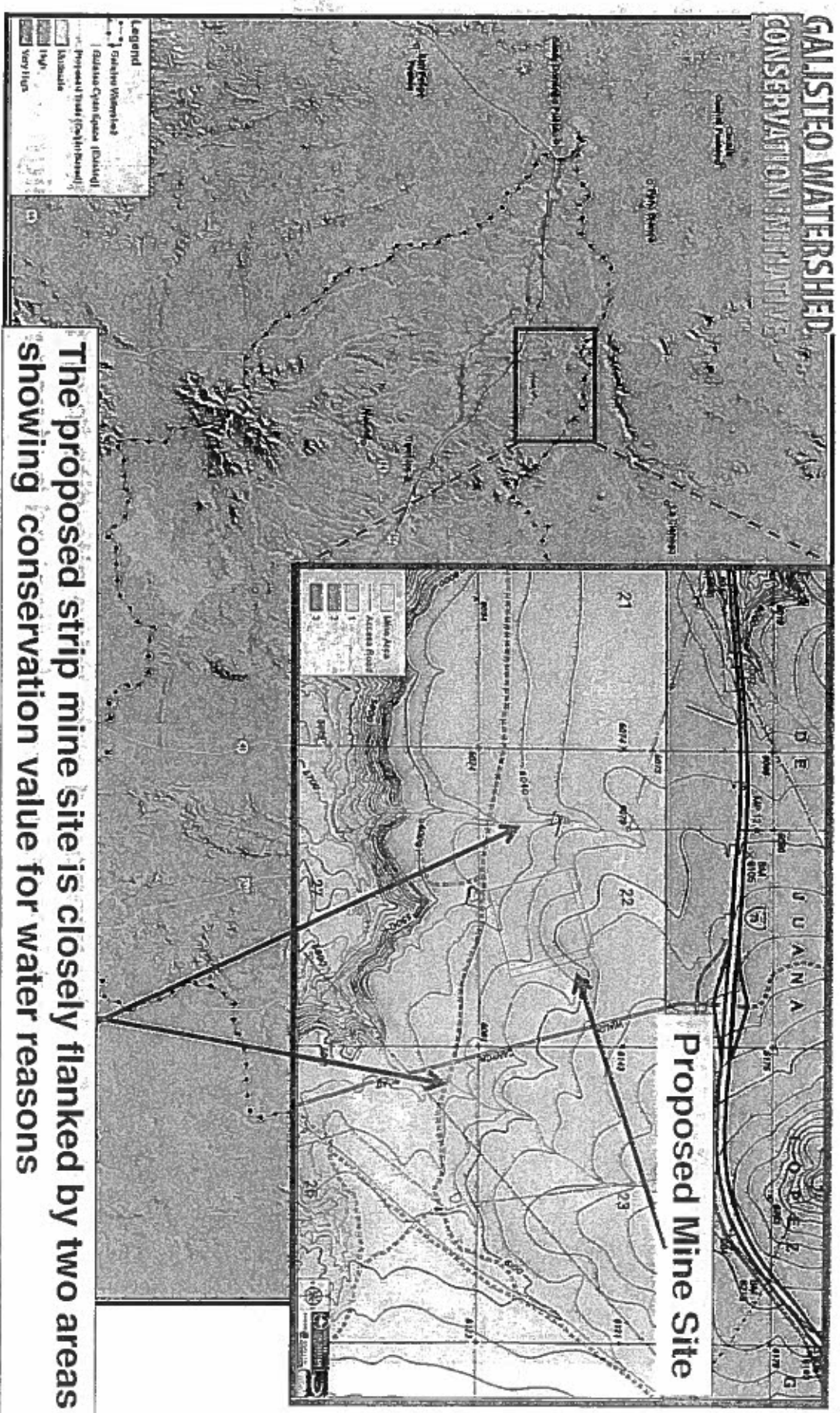

Ecological Importance of La Bajada Mesa Habitat Value Map



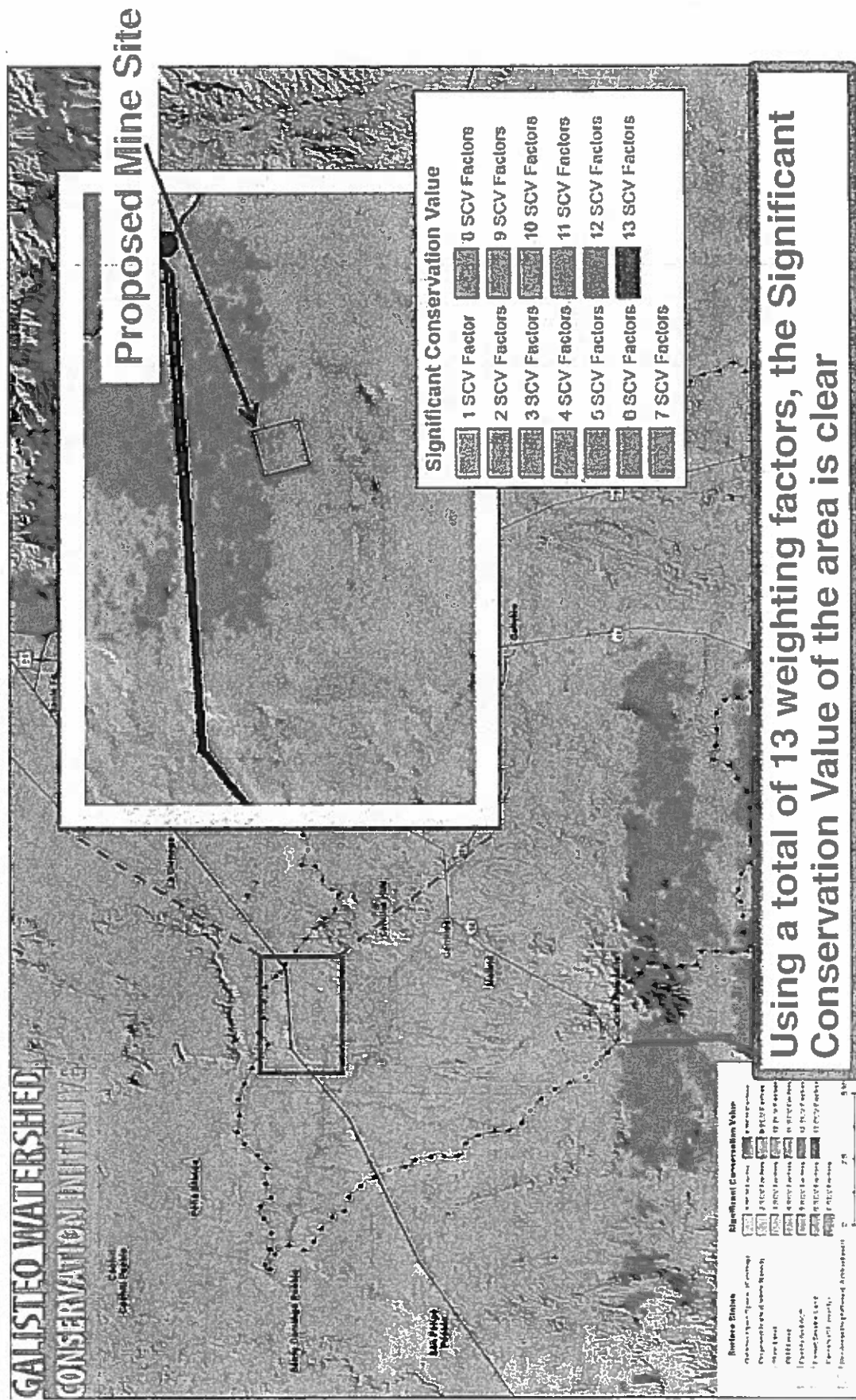
Ecological Importance of La Bajada Mesa Water Value Map

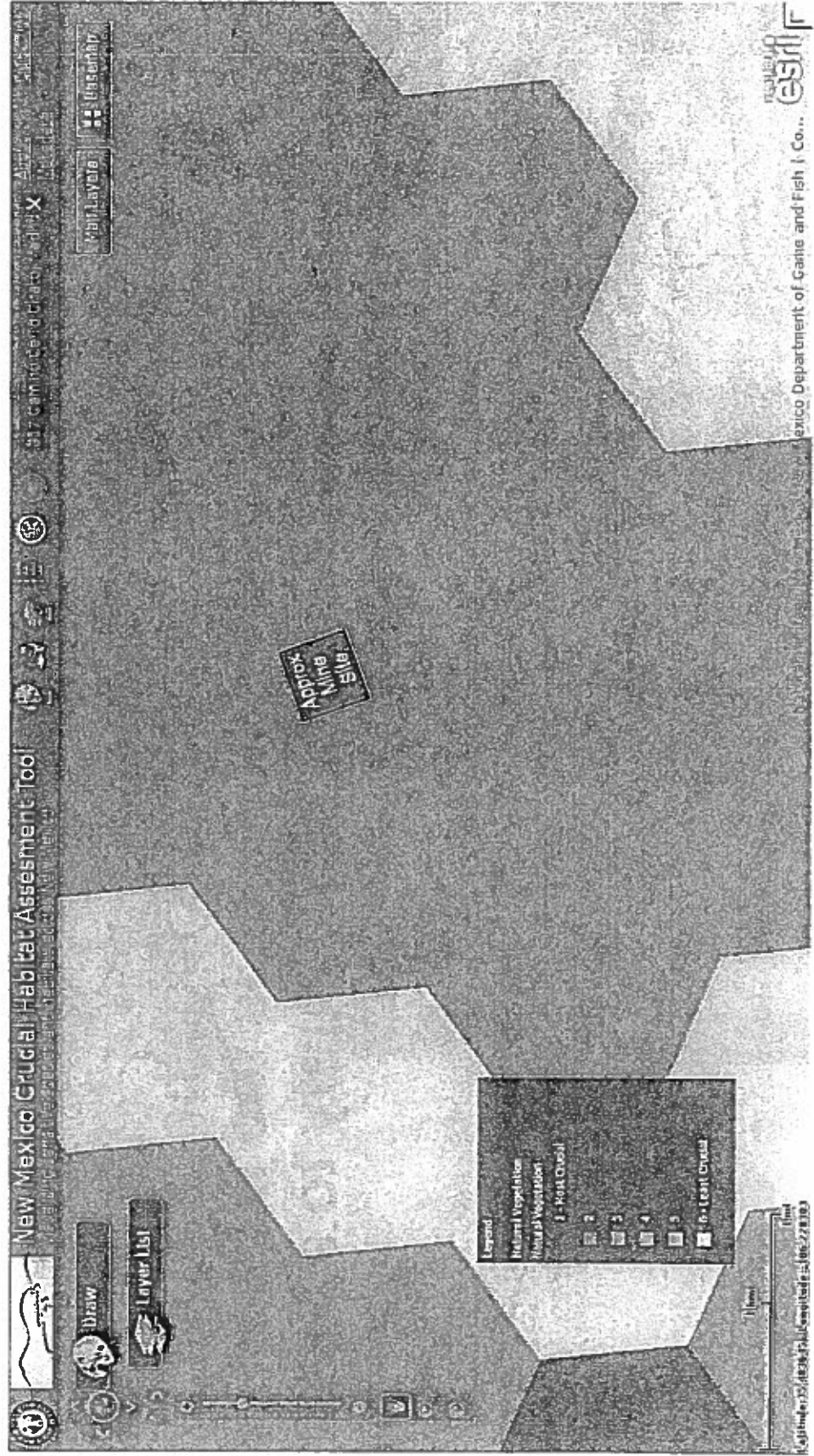


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Ecological Importance of La Bajada Mesa Crucial Habitat

La Bajada Mesa Too Ecologically Important to Strip Mine

Any one of the ecological factors discussed in this presentation is reason enough to deny the application before you today.

The weight of all of these factors together leaves no room for doubt – **La Bajada Mesa is too important to the ecological health of our County to allow it to be re-zoned for mining.**

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Summary

La Bajada Mesa Strip Mine Application Summary

As you have just heard:

1. The application **fails to meet several different Code requirements.**
2. The application is **riddled with inaccuracies and misrepresentations.**
3. Even if adjustments were made to bring the application into compliance with County Code, **denial would still be warranted** for a variety of other factors over which the County has jurisdiction and authority.

The County is not obligated to grant the applicants' request for re-zoning but it is obligated to protect the best interest of its citizens. **The evidence is overwhelming – the County must deny this ill-conceived application.**
