(CDBG) Process and Schedule

SUMMARY:

The New Mexico Department of Finance and Administration (NMDFA), Local Government Division (LGD), Community Development Bureau (CDB) has initiated the 2017 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application process for 2017. The CDBG program is federally funded and passes grant funds through NMDFA/LGD/CDB for community development projects related to needed infrastructure, public buildings, housing rehabilitation, economic development, planning and other critical projects which are identified by local municipalities and counties.

BACKGROUND:

This presentation is to inform the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) that staff will be attending the CDBG Application workshop on March 15, 2017. Following the workshop, staff will present to the BCC regarding specific steps needed to complete an application for the 2017 CDBG grant cycle. Staff will also work with the BCC to conduct two public hearings to request proposals and select a potential project for inclusion in the 2017 application cycle. The following bullet points identify key dates in the 2017 CDBG process:

- CDBG Application Workshop March 15, 2017
- Application deadline- June 23, 2017
- Applicant notice of eligibility July 5, 2017
- Selection of projects for grant award September 2017
