A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING SANTA FE COUNTY MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH PLANNING COUNCIL'S EFFORTS TO IMPROVE MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH IN SANTA FE COUNTY AND IN NEW MEXICO

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Santa Fe County and New Mexico for every child to receive adequate health care services; and

WHEREAS, full utilization of Title XXI federal funding opportunities will extend full health insurance coverage for many children in New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, a patient protection act will safeguard patient rights for managed health care enrollees; and

WHEREAS, medicaid managed care legislation can facilitate access and choice for perinatal and well child care; and

WHEREAS, a welfare reform act has the opportunity to support long-term self-sufficiency for recipients; and

WHEREAS, WIC (WOMEN, INFANTS, AND CHILDREN) needs expanded funding to provide good nutrition and education to serve all eligible recipients; and

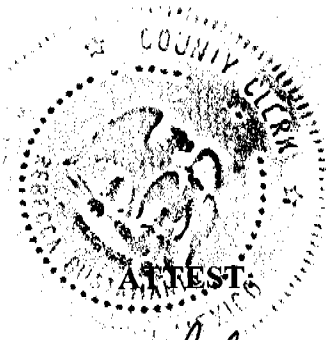
WHEREAS, the UNM Nurse Midwifery Program must have state funding to continue its education program.

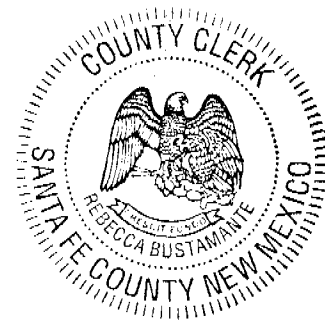
