## A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE TRADITIONAL COMMUNITY BOUNDARY OF EL VALLE DE ARROYO SECO PURSUANT TO COUNTY ORDINANCE 1998-5, THE COMMUNITY PLANNING PROCESS.

WHEREAS, the El Valle de Arroyo Seco is requesting amendment of their Traditional Community Planning Boundary; and

WHEREAS, the community is concerned about water supply and having a voice in the future development on public land; and

WHEREAS, the community has received approval from Bureau of Land Management (BLM) for inclusion of public lands into El Valle de Arroyo Seco Planning Boundary; and

WHEREAS, public hearings were held before the Board of County Commissioners on September 14, 1999 and October 12, 1999 to consider the approval of the El Valle de Arroyo Seco Planning Boundary; and

WHEREAS, the requirements of the County Ordinance 1998-5, the Community Planning Process, for boundary amendments have been complied with; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Boundary shall not constitute an amendment to the Traditional Community Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, County Development Review Committee considered the amendment to the Traditional Community Planning Boundary on August 26, 1999, and made a conditional approval with recommended changes; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of Santa Fe County that El Valle de Arroyo Seco Planning Boundary, attached as Exhibit A, is hereby adopted.
