A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A TRAIL EASEMENT DEDICATION ADJACENT TO THE SANTA FE RIVER NEAR THE AGUA FRIA VILLAGE

WHEREAS, the 1999 Santa Fe County Growth Management Plan states that the County will work with residents and property owners to identify open space and trails that are significant to protect; and

WHEREAS, the County's draft Open Space and Trail Plan, based on citizen input, recommends a trail along the Santa Fe River; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe's Park, Trails and Open Space Plan identifies the Santa Fe River as an important trail corridor to acquire; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) approached the Planning Division about donating a trail easement along the Santa Fe River to the County; and

WHEREAS, the County agrees to survey the trail easement as a condition to accepting the donation by BLM: and

WHEREAS, the trail easement is highlighted and enlarged on Exhibit A, attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, this easement, approximately ½ mile in length, will provide a vital link for a trail along the Santa Fe River; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has authority to accept the trail easement dedication.







A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the Fourth Standard Parallel North, a portion of the First Guide Meridian East, and certain small holding claim boundaries in section 31, designed to restore the corners in their true original location according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of section 31, the survey of a portion of the thalweg of the Santa Fe River in section 31, and the survey of certain lot boundaries in section 31, Township 17 North, Range 9 East, New Mexico Principal Meridian, New Mexico.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plats approved April 24, 1911 and September 26, 1919.

Survey executed by Thomas A. Maestas, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning January 10, 1984, and completed April 18, 1992, pursuant to Special Instructions dated August 18, 1993, for Group No. 926, New Mexico.
