## **A Resolution Requesting the Assistance of the Santa Fe County Health Planning Commission in addressing the County's interest in a Detoxification Facility, Adolescent Health and Rural Health Care Access**

---

**Whereas**, the County of Santa Fe adopted the following statement of its commitment to the community;

*Santa Fe County government recognizes that the manner in which health care and community services are being delivered is rapidly changing. Active public involvement with our residents, service providers, community-based organizations, and educational institutions is necessary to ensure affordable, quality, accessible, prevention oriented health and community services that are responsive to our diverse demographics and geography.*

**Whereas**, the County of Santa Fe adopted the following health mission statement;

*Santa Fe County is committed to the improvement, protection and accessibility of existing health services. The County will utilize partnerships with health organizations that will enhance and increase the level of health care provided to Santa Fe County residents and communities.*

**Whereas**, Santa Fe County adopted a County Health Plan that includes as one of its goals to define the County's specific roles and responsibilities in meeting new health care challenges;

**Whereas**, the County of Santa Fe created a Health Planning Commission that maintains the responsibility to recommend health and human services policies in an advisory capacity to the Board of County Commissioners;

Whereas, the County of Santa Fe finds the high costs of both incarceration and medical treatment of drug and alcohol users to be an issue of concern to county residents that may be addressed through the creation of a Santa Fe County detoxification facility;

Whereas, the accessibility of health care to rural county residents is an issue of concern to Santa Fe County;

Whereas, the health of Santa Fe County adolescent residents is an issue of concern to Santa Fe County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SANTA FE COUNTY asks the Santa Fe County Health Planning Commission to make recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners regarding the County's interest in a detoxification facility, rural health care access and adolescent health.
