A RESOLUTION REQUIRING LANDOWNERS TO DEDICATE FIVE PERCENT OF THE PURCHASE PRICE TO ESTABLISH A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND MAINTENANCE FUND FOR THE WILDLIFE, MOUNTAINS, TRAILS AND HISTORIC PLACES PROGRAM

WHEREAS, voters in Santa Fe County approved a General Obligation Bond establishing funding for the "Wildlife, Mountains, Trails and Historic Places Program," ("Program") on November 3, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the County is acquiring lands for the Program to preserve historic and natural areas, mountains and foothills, arroyos and river parkways, sacred sites, trails and high desert habitats, and establish neighborhood parks and playfields; and

WHEREAS, the County does not have adequate funds set aside through the General Fund or other funds to pay for capital improvements and maintenance of properties acquired for the Program.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) of Santa Fe County that:

In all future property acquisition negotiations for the Wildlife, Mountains, Trails and Historic Places Program, the County requires that participating landowners donate five (5) percent of the purchase price at the time of closing. This money shall be placed in an account to fund capital improvements and maintenance of properties acquired for the Program.
