A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SANTA FE COUNTY SOLID WASTE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the County Solid Waste program has undergone numerous changes over the past several years; and

WHEREAS, changes in the Solid Waste Program have the potential to directly affect citizens across the County; and

WHEREAS, a dedicated planning effort involving staff as well the public provides for efficient and well-timed implementation and direction for any future changes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County that:

1. The Solid Waste Advisory Committee be established to prepare a Five (5)-Year Solid Waste Management Plan in conjunction with the Solid Waste Division of Santa Fe County to address curbside collection, infrastructure development, operations, disposal sites, rate structure, recycling, household hazardous wastes, illegal dumping, coordination among government entities, and other topics, as needed.
2. The Solid Waste Management Plan, upon completion, be presented to the Board of County Commissioners for approval.
3. The Solid Waste Advisory Committee shall include two (2) Commission appointees per district, and one (1) alternate per district.
4. The Solid Waste Advisory Committee will adhere to the Rules of Order for Santa Fe County Boards and Commissions.


