## *Resolution No. 2001-11*

---

### **A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A GRANT APPLICATION TO NEW MEXICO STATE PARKS DIVISION FOR RECREATIONAL TRAILS FUNDING AND AUTHORIZING A LOCAL FUNDS MATCH FOR SANTA FE RIVER**

---

WHEREAS, the Federal Recreation Trails Program (RTP), or "TEA 21," has allocated \$754,000 to New Mexico State Parks Division's Recreational Trails Funding Program in FY2001. The program provides an 80 percent federal grant for each project with a 20 percent local match; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe County Open Land and Trails Plan calls for the establishment of interconnecting trail systems for pedestrians and bicycles throughout the region; and

WHEREAS, the County Open Land and Trails Planning and Advisory Committee has recommended that the County leverage local funds whenever possible for the Wildlife, Mountains, Trails and Historic Places Program; and

WHEREAS, El Camino Real River Connection (CRRC) is a broad-based community group which has come together for the purpose of creating a well-maintained, supervised pedestrian trail and bikeway along the Santa Fe River; and

WHEREAS, a trail along the River will ultimately become part of a regional trail system; and

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County, in partnership with The Santa Fe Conservation Trust and El Camino Real River Connection, wishes to receive funding to obtain easements for the creation of a pedestrian trail and bikeway along the Santa Fe River; and

WHEREAS, the cost of acquiring said easements is approximately \$200,000; and

WHEREAS, for the proposed \$200,000 project, \$40,000 is necessary for the local match in order to be awarded \$160,000 federal match through TEA 21.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners  
(BCC) of Santa Fe County that: 1853159

The Governing Body supports the TEA-21 Recreational Trails Program application to be submitted to the New Mexico State Parks Division in February 2001, and authorizes a local funds match.





