A RESOLUTION DECLARING A STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR THE SOUTHERN AREA OF SANTA FE COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Southern area of Santa Fe County has suffered severe problems and property damage caused by heavy snow fall and high winds on the 30th day of January, 2001; and

WHEREAS, traffic movement has been brought to a halt endangering life and property, and many County roads have been closed; and

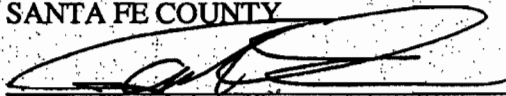
WHEREAS, these problems have resulted in undue human suffering and hardship and threatens the safety, health, welfare, and well-being of citizens and the economic function of Santa Fe County; and

WHEREAS, all locally available public and private resources now available to mitigate and alleviate the damages are deemed insufficient to cope with the resulting situation, to initiate repairs, and to meet restoration requirement.

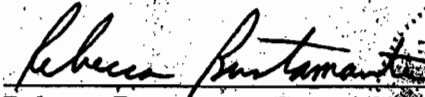
NOW, THEREFORE, the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners, by virtue of the authority provided by the New Mexico Civil Emergency Preparedness Act (NMSA 1978, 12-10-01 to 12-10-11) does hereby declare the Southern area of Santa Fe County to be a disaster area for the purpose of exercising necessary emergency powers and expenditure of available resources, and requesting aid, assistance, relief and program funds available from the State of New Mexico.

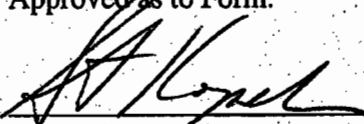
