Resolution No. 2001- 140

A RESOLUTION CONDEMNING TERRORIST ATTACKS AND SUPPORTING OUR PRESIDENT AND CONGRESS IN THEIR RESPONSE TO OUR NATIONAL CRISIS.

WHEREAS, on September 11, 2001, America was suddenly and brutally attacked by terrorists, and;

WHEREAS, these terrorists hijacked and destroyed four civilian aircraft, crashing two of them into the towers of the World Trade Center in New York City, a third into the Pentagon outside Washington, DC, and the fourth diverted from its original target, and;

WHEREAS, thousands of innocent Americans were killed and injured as a result of these attacks, including the passengers and crew of the four aircraft, workers in the World Trade Center and in the Pentagon, rescue workers, and bystanders, and;

WHEREAS, these cowardly acts were by far the deadliest terrorist attacks ever launched against the United States, and, by targeting symbols of American strength and success, clearly were intended to harm our nation and weaken its resolve, and;

WHEREAS, these horrific events have affected all Americans and indeed impacted the future of our safety both nationally and internationally, and;

WHEREAS, these cowardly acts of terrorism resolve us as Americans to respond through our heritage, as a nation to stand tall and proud; to confront and combat terrorism,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Santa Fe Board of County Commissioners condemns the cowardly and deadly actions of these terrorists, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Santa Fe Board of County Commissioners support the President of the United States, as he works with his national security team to defend against additional attacks, and find the terrorists, their harbor and support systems to bring them to justice, and;

BE IT STILL FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Santa Fe Board of County Commissioners recommend to Santa Fe County residents to support relief efforts in whatever capacity can be expressed.
