RESOLUTION NO. 2001-153**A RESOLUTION OFFICIALLY CHANGING THE ROAD NAME OF DANCING BUFFALO TO CAMINO CERRADO IN THE VICINITY OF THE COMMUNITY OF POJOAQUE.**

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners is authorized to do all things necessary to provide for the safety and preserve the health of the County or its inhabitants within statutory and constitutional limitations, and

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinances 1990-05 and 1996-14 to provide for rural addressing and requisite road naming within the County; and

Whereas, Ordinance 1996-14 empowers Board of County Commissioners to change existing road names to serve the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SANTA FE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

Section 1. The previously accepted official road name for an approximately .8 mile long road near the community of Pojoaque running west of intersection of US Highway 84/285 and State Road 503 be changed from Dancing Buffalo to Camino Cerrado.

Section 2. That the officers and employees of the Board of County Commissioners are hereby directed and requested to take such other action as may be required to complete this road name change.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
