**A JOINT CITY/COUNTY RESOLUTION**

**REQUESTING LEGISLATIVE FUNDING FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR DEVELOPING  
WATER DIVERSION AND TRANSMISSION FACILITIES ON SANTO DOMINGO LANDS TO  
SUPPLY POTABLE WATER NEEDS.**

**WHEREAS**, the County and the City are experiencing significant growth and acknowledge the value and need to promote effective water resource management; and

**WHEREAS**, the County and the City own and operate water utilities that service Santa Fe and surrounding areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the County and the City have long range plans to utilize their respective water utilities to assist other communities including its Pueblo neighbors with their potable water supply needs; and

**WHEREAS**, the County and the City have the need to develop water supply sources and to acquire water rights to further their goals of providing water supply to meet present and future demands; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to a memorandum of understanding, Santo Domingo has agreed to

1 participate in a feasibility study that will allow for the necessary gathering of information to pursue the  
2 development of water diversion and transmission facilities to supply water needs as defined by the  
3 feasibility study; and





4 WHEREAS, the County and the City recognize the need and desire for alternative funding  
5 sources for capital outlay projects.


6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY
