A RESOLUTION REQUESTING FUNDING THROUGH THE 2001 NEW MEXICO STATE HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT LOCAL GOVERNMENT ROAD FUND PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to utilize the funds available in the Local Government Road Fund to improve County Road 73. County Road 73 is approximately three miles in length and is located in the Village of Tesuque. The proposed improvements include drainage and paving.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Local Government Road Fund the New Mexico State Highway and Transportation Department ("Department") requires that Santa Fe County match funding for the proposed project.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners will hold a meeting on February 27, 2001, to formalize its written application to the Department to give authorization to match the funds in accordance with the Local Government Road Fund Program.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners authorizes the matching of funds for the 2001 New Mexico State Highway and Transportation Department Local Government Road Fund Program.
