EMERGENCY DECLARATION FOR THE SANTA FE COUNTY SOLID WASTE DEPARTMENT TO PURCHASE CERTAIN EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners on March 13, 2001, the following was among the proceedings; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to authorize an emergency procurement of a Roll-off Bin Waste Collection Truck for Solid Waste Department; and,

WHEREAS, said procurement is to replace old equipment currently in non-running condition; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant of Section 13-01-127 NMSA 1978 of the State Procurement Code, emergency procurements are allowed when the emergency condition is a situation which creates a threat to public health, welfare or safety as may arise from equipment failures or similar events; and,

WHEREAS, the equipment to be purchased is to replace equipment currently assigned to the Santa Fe County Solid Waste Department and is needed to properly perform the duties of that department; and,


WHEREAS, the Santa Fe County Solid Waste Department has sufficient unexpended cash balance augmented by contingency funds from the County Manager for this procurement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County, New Mexico that the emergency procurement be allowed in accordance with guidelines of Section 13-1-127 NMSA 1978 of the New Mexico Procurement Code.




