A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A LOCAL DEVELOPMENT REVIEW COMMITTEE FOR THE SANTA FE COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners approved Resolution No. 2000-148 on 31 October, 2000, adopting the Santa Fe Community College District Plan.

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners approved Ordinance No. 2000-12 on 11 December, 2000, adopting the Santa Fe Community College District Ordinance.

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe County Land Development Code, Article II Section 1.3, authorizes the establishment of a Local Development Review Committee (LDRC) following the adoption of a local Land Use Plan for an approved region in the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) of Santa Fe County that:


1. The BCC shall appoint a Local Development Review Committee for the Santa Fe Community College District which will hereinafter be named Community College Development Review Committee and referred to as the "Committee" and shall serve as a planning commission, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 3-19-1 and the Land Development Code.
2. The Santa Fe County Planning Division staff will coordinate a process whereby interested parties will submit nomination letters to the BCC indicating their interest in serving on the Committee. The letters must state that the nominee is a resident, property owner and/or business owner in the Santa Fe Community College District as per the qualifications for serving on a LDRC as described in the Santa Fe County Land Development Code, Article II Section 1.3.1b.
3. The Committee will consist of no less than five (5) members and shall be appointed by the BCC pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 3-19-2. Terms shall be staggered with a majority of members being appointed for one-year terms and the remainder being appointed for two-year terms. A majority of members shall be residents of the Community College District area.
4. The Committee members will represent the diverse interests of the Community College District. The members of the Committee should collectively possess a diversity of skills and knowledge including but not limited to land-use, community planning, environmental systems, water issues and hydrological

systems, agricultural issues, community history and culture, and posses the ability to fairly and impartially review various types of development proposals.


5. It is the BCC's intention to have the Committee serve in an advisory capacity for projects requiring EZC review.
6. The BCC will appoint members to the Committee based on letters of interest, qualifications, and community-wide representation.




