## A RESOLUTION CLARIFYING THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO THE COUNTY DEVELOPMENT REVIEW COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 1.2.1 of the County Land Development Code requires the appointment of no less than seven (7) members to the County Development Review Committee (CDRC), and

WHEREAS, in order to provide a diversity of representation, these members shall reside in different areas of the County, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners to allow each Commissioner to nominate a CDRC member.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County that:

- 1. Each member of the Board of County Commissioners will nominate at least one appointment to the County Development Review Committee; and
- 2. One County Development Review Committee member shall reside in the incorporated boundaries of the City of Santa Fe; and
- 3. Terms shall be staggered with a majority of members being appointed for one-year terms and the remainder being appointed for two-year terms.
