A RESOLUTION REPLACING RESOLUTION 1991-52 "ESTABLISHING DEVELOPMENT PERMIT AND REVIEW FEES"

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County has determined that, wherever possible, the applicant for any type of development in the County, including the Extraterritorial Zone, should be required to pay for certain fees which are directly related to its application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) of Santa Fe County that:

The following fees shall be paid by any applicant for development and review, pursuant to the Santa Fe County Land Use Code, Ordinance 1996-10 as amended and the Extraterritorial Zoning Ordinance, EZA 1997-4 as amended and the Extraterritorial Subdivision Regulations, Ordinance 1991-11 as amended:


