## A Resolution of Support for Health Centers of Northern New Mexico and Las Cumbres Learning Services Shared Facility

---

**WHEREAS**, Health Centers of Northern New Mexico provides primary medical care to the over 5,000 mostly low income and uninsured people as well as service veterans per year in its Española clinics;

**WHEREAS**, Substantial proportion of these patients reside in northern Santa Fe County, including parts of Española, Chimayo, Arroyo Seco, and other areas surrounding Española on the Santa Fe side of the county line;

**WHEREAS**, At the Health Centers of Northern New Mexico Peñasco Dental Clinic approximately 20% of the practice (240 patients out of the total of 1,200 annual users) reside in Santa Fe County, helping to alleviate an acute shortage of affordable dental services for the uninsured and low income population;

**WHEREAS**, Health Centers of Northern New Mexico has occupied the same Española clinic building at 620 Coronado Street for 20 years and the building is over 25 years old and no longer adequate to meet the needs of all those who need health care services there;

**WHEREAS**, Las Cumbres Learning Services serves approximately 5,000 mostly low income clients per year at its 404 Hunter Street building, providing a range of services to children birth to 18 with developmental delays and other problems, adults with developmental disabilities and families and caretakers of these people;

**WHEREAS**, many Las Cumbres Learning Services clients and staff live in northern Santa Fe County;

**WHEREAS**, Las Cumbres Learning Services has been in this same building for 14 years despite a tripling of the number of clients served over the past decade; and

WHEREAS, These two non-profit organizations have formed a collaboration to seek a new shared facility to make their services accessible and convenient to a larger number of people;



**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**


