RESOLUTION NO. 2006- 122

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION NOS. 2006-102, 2006-113 AND 2006-79 ("A RESOLUTION TO PROCLAIM EXTREME OR SEVERE DROUGHT CONDITIONS WITHIN SANTA FE COUNTY AND TO BAN THE SALE AND USE OF CERTAIN FIREWORKS IN THE UNINCORPORATED PORTIONS OF THE COUNTY AND WITHIN WILD LANDS IN THE COUNTY") BECAUSE OF IMPROVING SHORT-TERM DROUGHT CONDITIONS AND THE LESSENED THREAT TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioner (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") previously approved its Resolution Nos. 2006-102, 2006-113 and 2006-79, which proclaimed extreme or severe drought conditions within Santa Fe County and banned the sale and use of certain fireworks in the unincorporated areas of the County and within wild lands of the County;

WHEREAS, recent rains have improved short-term drought conditions to the extent that extreme or severe drought conditions no longer exist within the County, the immediate threat to the public health, safety and welfare no longer exists, and the emergency measures contained in Resolution Nos. 2006-102, 2006-113 and 2006-79 are no longer needed;

WHEREAS, emergency measures such as those contained in Resolution Nos. 2006-102, 2006-113 and 2006-79 should only persist as long as the conditions that originally justified the emergency measures, and since the emergency conditions have abated, Resolution No. 2006-102, 2006-113 and 2006-79 should be rescinded, effective immediately;

WHEREAS, staff should continue to monitor conditions and be prepared to recommend that appropriate measures be reinstated should emergency conditions reoccur.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Resolution Nos. 2006-102, 2006-113 and 2006-79, which proclaimed extreme or severe drought conditions within Santa Fe County and banned the sale and use of certain fireworks in the unincorporated areas of the County and within wild lands of the County, is hereby rescinded, effective immediately.

2. Staff is directed to monitor conditions and, in the event that emergency conditions reoccur, is directed to bring to the Board appropriate measures to address thethen existing conditions.
