RESOLUTION NO. 2006-22

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A COMMUNITY PLANNING COMMITTEE, PLANNING BOUNDARIES, AND AUTHORIZATION TO INITIATE A COMMUNITY PLANNING PROCESS FOR THE VILLAGE OF GALISTEO

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted the County Growth Management Plan on October 26, 1999, in part to plan areas of Santa Fe County that are designated as Traditional Communities; and

WHEREAS, the 1980 General Plan and the County Growth Management Plan define Traditional Communities as settlement areas with "(1) 75 or more years of continuous settlement; (2) an historic pattern of land use or development; (3) historic structures; and (4) existence of village center or centers"; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Historic Preservation Division registered the Galisteo Historic District on the State Register of Cultural Properties on April 1, 1999; and

WHEREAS, the County Growth Management Plan recognizes that the "capacity for future growth in each community was limited and if the settlements continue to grow they could lose their identity and lifestyle"; and

WHEREAS, the County Growth Management Plan recognizes that "a thorough understanding of the design and planning elements on which Traditional Community is based is not only a resource for the community, but also a model for future development in the county"; and

WHEREAS, the County Growth Management Plan recognizes the need for the "communities (to) develop community plans which incorporate growth policies which coordinate land use and water management decisions, consistent with the desires of the community residents"; and

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County Ordinance No. 2002-03, also known as the Community Planning Ordinance, is an ordinance outlining a Community Planning Process for the development of Community Plans; and

WHEREAS, the Community Planning Ordinance outlines a Planning Process that includes an Application Process, Participation and Representation, Letter of Application from a Planning Committee, and Community Planning Boundaries; and


WHEREAS. The Galisteo Community Planning Committee has met the requirements of the Community Planning Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County that:





