A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 1999-137, THE SANTA FE COUNTY GROWTH MANAGEMENT PLAN, AS AMENDED, TO ADOPT AND INCORPORATE THE POJOAQUE VALLEY COMMUNITY STRATEGIC PLAN.

WHEREAS, on December 10, 2002 the Board of County Commissioners approved Resolution 2002-168 which established the Pojoaque Valley Planning Committee and authorized the Planning Committee to initiate a community planning process in accordance with Article XIII of the Santa Fe County Land Development Code; and

WHEREAS, the Pojoaque Valley Traditional Community District was identified as the planning boundary; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Committee concerns included growth within the Pojoaque Valley Traditional Community boundary, as well as protection of the historical rural nature of the Valley, opportunities to grow the local economy, the use of open space for health and recreational opportunities and other community needs; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Committee sought representation from the community and worked within a consensus process to establish a vision, goals, and recommended actions to create public places that support community and serve the youth, ensure a clean water supply, strengthen and build community relationships and communication, increase local input into zoning regulations, grow the local economy, and to create a planning authority that looks after the interests of the Valley; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Committee held regular bi-monthly meetings which were open to the public and held two community-wide forums and one community-wide open house to present the Plan and receive input from the community along with other community outreach methods; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Committee reached consensus to approve the Pojoaque Valley Community Strategic Plan on June 7th, 2007; and the County Development Review Committee recommended approval of the Pojoaque Valley Community Strategic Plan on June 21st, 2007 ; and

WHEREAS, the Pojoaque Valley Community Strategic Plan meets the required elements in Article XIII of the Land Use Development Code and the Santa Fe County

Community Planning Ordinance (Ordinance 2002-3). The Plan will be a tool to support the important values of the community and the vision for the future of the Pojoaque Valley; and

WHEREAS, the policies of the Pojoaque Valley Community Strategic Plan conform to the overall goals and policies of the Santa Fe County Growth Management Plan (Resolution 1999-137); and

WHEREAS, the status of community, neighborhood, and district plans is advisory only and is to be used as a guideline for the review and approval of recommendations for program actions, zoning changes or ordinance amendments, or capital improvements programming.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County that:

- 1) The Pojoaque Valley Community Strategic Plan, attached to this Resolution, is hereby adopted; and
- 2) Resolution 1999-137, the Santa Fe Growth Management Plan, is hereby amended to incorporate the Pojoaque Valley Community Strategic Plan.




