A RESOLUTION FOR DONATION OF REGION III DRUG ENFORCEMENT TASK FORCE FIXED ASSET EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 13-6-1 (2001) authorizes the governing authority of a local public body to dispose of items of personal property upon a finding by the authority that the property has a resale value of \$5,000 or less and is worn-out, unusable or obsolete to the extent that the item is no longer economical;


WHEREAS, the Town of Taos Police Department, New Mexico, has requested the donation of a copier from the County to use in assisting their personnel in their job duties;

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe County Region III Drug Enforcement Task Force has replaced the copier with an upgraded model and, therefore, the requested copier (Santa Fe County tag number 015198) is no longer being used by the County; and

WHEREAS, the requested copier has an estimated current resale value of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or less and is unusable by the County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County that the Santa Fe County Region III Drug Enforcement Task Force shall, upon approval of the state auditor, donate the copier to the Town of Taos Police Department.
