Resolution No. 2007 - 47

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE COUNTY MANAGER'S REORGANIZATION PLAN WHICH REORGANIZES SANTA FE COUNTY INTO FOUR MAJOR DEPARTMENTS TO BE KNOWN AS "ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES," "CORRECTIONS," "GROWTH MANAGEMENT" AND "COMMUNITY SERVICES;" AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MANAGER TO APPOINT CERTAIN PERSONS AS DIRECTOR OF EACH DEPARTMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MANAGER TO RECLASSIFY CERTAIN EMPLOYEES WITHIN THE REORGANIZED COUNTY STRUCTURE.

WHEREAS, on, March 28, 2006, the Board of County Commissioners approved Resolution No. 2006-58, which adopted a Strategic Planning Process for managing Santa Fe County growth;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2006-58, the Strategic Planning Process was to address and make recommendations concerning the County's internal organizational structure and develop actions and implementation plans for reorganization of Santa Fe County government, excluding the offices managed by the County Clerk, the County Treasurer, the County Assessor, the County Sheriff and the County Probate Judge;

WHEREAS, a Strategic Plan was developed pursuant to the direction of Resolution No. 2006-58, and that Plan distinguishes among essential, core, and support services for County citizens for implementation of growth management planning, and also identifies possibilities for reorganization to accommodate the future direction of County government to meet the objectives of the Plan;

WHEREAS, the County Manager believes that reorganization of County government is necessary to fully implement the recommendations of the Strategic Plan, promote maximum efficiencies in County government, and increase opportunities for interdepartmental cooperation and collaboration, and, accordingly, the County Manager has developed a reorganization plan (see attachment A) that, in his view, promotes the objectives of the Strategic Plan and represents a more workable management structure; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners agrees with the County Manager and wishes to approve the proposed reorganization plan, and to delegate authority to the County Manager to complete the reorganization.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SANTA FE COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The County Manager's reorganization plan shall be and hereby is approved. A diagram of the reorganized County government is attached hereto as Attachment A.

2. All County departments, with the exception of Human Resources, the County Attorney's Office, and Elected Official offices, shall be reorganized into four (4) major Departments, these being Administrative Services, Corrections, Growth Management, and Community Services.

3. Appointment of the leadership of the new Departments shall occur immediately. The County Manager shall appoint Directors of the new Administrative Services Department, Growth Management Department, Corrections Department, and Community Services Department. The County Manager's choices for Directors of these Departments (James Lujan, Growth Management; Joseph Gutierrez, Community Services; Peter Garcia, Administrative Services; Annabelle Romero, Corrections) are acceptable and are hereby approved. The existing Department Heads of Land Use, Fire, Finance, Housing, Water Resources and Health shall become Division Directors within the newly formed Departments, as shown on Attachment A.

4. Employees, functions and resources assigned to the former departments shall be assigned by the County Manager to the newly formed Departments as necessary to accomplish the reorganization.

4. The County Manager shall be authorized to make further organizational, classification and interdepartmental transfers as necessary to implement the reorganization.
