A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION, LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION, TO PARTICIPATE IN THE LOCAL DWI GRANT AND DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Legislature enacted NMSA 1978, Sections 11-6A-1 through 11-6A-6 (1978) (as amended) to address the serious problems of Driving While Intoxicated in the State; and

WHEREAS, a program has been established to make grant and distribution funding available to counties and municipalities for new, innovative, or model programs, services or activities to prevent or reduce the incidence of DWI, alcoholism and alcohol abuse; and

WHEREAS, the County, along with participating agencies, wish to apply to the Department of Finance and Administration, Local Government Division, for program funding; and


WHEREAS, the Santa Fe County's DWI Planning Council and other governmental entities must receive approval in order to apply for grant and distribution funding.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County that the County Chairperson of the DWI Planning Council, is authorized to submit an application for grant and distribution program funding, on behalf of the County, under the regulations established by the Local Government Division.



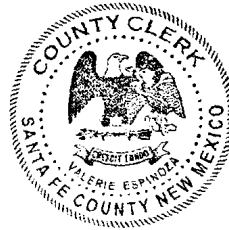
