11	SUPPORTING THE SANTA FE REGIONAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS COALITION'S
12	EFFORTS TO ORGANIZE PRIMARY TELECOMMUNICATIONS BANDWIDTH USERS IN
13	THE SANTA FE REGION; AND DIRECTING STAFF TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO
14	THE NEW MEXICO LAMBDA RAIL.

16	WHEREAS, the National LambdaRail™ ("NLR") is a high-speed national computer network in
17	the United States that runs over fiber-optic lines, and is the first transcontinental Ethernet network; and
18	WHEREAS, the University of New Mexico ("UNM") on behalf of the State of New Mexico is a
19	member of the NLR; and
20	WHEREAS, the New Mexico Lambda Rail ("NMLR") Initiative is a partnership formed by
21	UNM, New Mexico State University and the New Mexico Institute of Mining and Technology, to provide
22	direct high-speed access within Governor Richardson's Wire New Mexico Initiative; and
23	WHEREAS, Santa Fe Regional Telecommunications Coalition ("SFRTC") was created to
24	organize primary telecommunications bandwidth users in the Santa Fe region with participation from
25	Santa Fe County, the City of Santa Fe, the Santa Fe Community College and the NMLR; and

WHEREAS, enhanced telecommunications infrastructure meets regional and local economic
development goals, enhancement of regional emergency services, e-government services, telehealth,
educational and research opportunities and improved quality of life for the Santa Fe region; and
WHEREAS, the SFRTC is a model for regional telecommunications infrastructure initiatives
that can be adopted by other regions, counties and municipalities and support for this model would benefit
both the Santa Fe region and the State of New Mexico; and
WHEREAS, the House of Representatives of the State of New Mexico adopted House Memorial
32 at the 2008 legislative session which requested support for the SFRTC; and
WHEREAS, House Memorial 32 requested that the New Mexico secretary of information
technology work with the SFRTC; and
WHEREAS, House Memorial 32 further requested the governor's science and technology
advisor work with SFRTC to arrange for the installation of a gateway to the New Mexico computing

WHEREAS, this resolution reflects a similar resolution that was adopted by the Santa Fe Community College Board on PRIL 17, 2008.

application center at Santa Fe Community College as a connection to the NMLR; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY

COMMISSIONERS OF SANTA FE COUNTY AND THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY

OF SANTA FE that their respective staff are directed to work collaboratively with the Santa Fe

Community College and the NMLR to develop and submit an application to NMLR for a high speed connection to NLR to meet the needs of SFRTC.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLEVED THAT** the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County and the Governing Body of the City of Santa Fe direct their respective staff to continue to work collaboratively for connection to the NLR for the Santa Fe County Media District for economic development uses and other qualifying uses to include telehealth, regional emergency services and other governmental uses within Santa Fe County and the City of Santa Fe.

1	BE IT FURTHER RESOLEVED THAT the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe
2	County and the Governing Body of the City of Santa Fe direct their respective staff to continue working
3	with the SFRTC and NMLR to develop recommendations on infrastructure and equipment requirements
4	and to determine membership costs so that Santa Fe County and the City of Santa Fe may be connected to
5	the NMLR network.
