A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE AND SALE AGREEMENT FOR PROPERTY IN SANTA FE COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe Mountain Center provides therapeutic services for at risk youth and adults in Santa Fe County; and

WHEREAS, legislative funds have been allocated for the County to purchase property for a therapeutic camp for at risk youth and adults; and


WHEREAS, in coordination with the Santa Fe Mountain Center, the County has identified property in Glorieta to serve as the site for the program; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to allow for a timely and efficient process for the purchase of this property in order to expend state appropriations dedicated to the County for the purchase of property for a therapeutic camp for at risk youth and adults;

WHEREAS, the Board desires to purchase this property for this purpose and authorizes the County Manager to execute all relevant documents necessary to effectuate the land purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Manager is authorized to execute all relevant documents concerning the purchase of an approximately 22.8 acre property on La Cueva Road, near the village of Glorieta, in Santa Fe County using legislative funds, for use as an overnight therapeutic camp for at risk youth and adults in Santa Fe County.
