

**THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
SANTA FE COUNTY**

Resolution No. 2009 - 98

A resolution authorizing the creation of an additional voting precinct that will encompass a majority of tribal citizens who reside within the interior boundaries of the Pueblo of Nambe Land Base in Northern Santa Fe County.

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 1-3-2 requires that the Board of County Commissioners by resolution create additional precincts to meet the requirements of NMSA 1978, Section 1-3-1;

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978 Section 1-3-1 requires that "each precinct as nearly as practicable shall be composed of contiguous and compact areas having clearly definable boundaries";

WHEREAS, a new and separate voting precinct encompassing the majority of tribal citizens who reside within the interior boundaries of the Pueblo of Nambe allows for a precinct that is composed of contiguous and compact areas having clearly definable boundaries;

WHEREAS, a new and separate voting precinct within the interior boundaries of the Pueblo of Nambe is in the interest of the convenience of voters in Santa Fe County;

WHEREAS, the Pueblo of Nambe has requested a new and separate precinct for the benefit of voters residing in the Pueblo of Nambe interior boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the attached Exhibit "A" designates the precinct boundaries of the new voting precinct within the interior boundaries of the Pueblo of Nambe Land Base in Santa Fe County and the corresponding boundary adjustments to adjacent voting precincts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County hereby establish a new voting precinct as designated in the attached Exhibit "A."








Exhibit A

New Precinct (within the interior boundaries of the Pueblo of Nambe Land Base in Northern Santa Fe County) Beginning at the southeast boundary of Nambe Pueblo; thence west on the Rio Nambe continuing to the Nambe Falls Lake; thence following the southern lake shore to the Nambe Falls Dam; thence northwest on the Rio Nambe to County Road 84F; thence northeast on County Road 84G; thence northwest on unnamed acequia to Nambe Pueblo Road 101; thence west on unnamed acequia; thence north on State Road 503 to Perez Road; thence west on Perez Road; thence following unnamed acequia until its terminus at State Road 503; thence north to Nambe Pueblo Northern Boundary; thence east to Nambe Pueblo Northeastern Boundary; thence back to the beginning following Nambe Pueblo Boundary.

Precinct 23 (Boundary Adjustment) Beginning at US 84/285 and NM 503; thence east on NM 503; thence west on Perez Road; thence following unnamed acequia until its terminus at State Road 503; thence north on NM 503 to Census Block boundary line before Juan Medina Road/County Road 98/NM 520 (the census line does not connect with Juan Medina Rd); thence west at Arroyo Seco Stream and continue west on stream until US 84/285; thence south on US 84/285 and back to beginning.

Precinct 61 (Boundary Adjustment) Beginning at US 84/285 and NM 503; thence south on US 84/285 to Arroyo Cuyamungue, which travels southeast and then turns back northeast; thence east on Nambe Pueblo Boundary Line; following Nambe Pueblo boundary line as it turns south; thence east and finally north; thence west on the Rio Nambe continuing to the Nambe Falls Lake; thence following the southern lake shore to the Nambe Falls Dam; thence northwest on the Rio Nambe to County Road 84F; thence northeast on County Road 84G; thence northwest on unnamed acequia to Nambe Pueblo Road 101; thence west on unnamed acequia; thence west on NM 503 and back to beginning.
