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**A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR COUNTY PARTICIPATION IN THE  
NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NMDOT) YEAR  
2012/2013 LOCAL GOVERNMENT ROAD IMPROVEMENT FUND  
PROGRAM (LGRF) COOPERATIVE PROJECT AGREEMENT PROJECT NO.  
CAP-5-13(470) FOR PAVEMENT REHABILITATION/IMPROVEMENTS ON  
CR 46 (ELLIS RANCH ROAD), RANCHO ALEGRE ROAD, CR 60 (NINE  
MILE ROAD), CR CAMINO MONTOYA, CR67J (DOUBLE ARROW ROAD)  
AND CR55 (GOLDMINE ROAD) IN SANTA FE COUNTY, NEW MEXICO**

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**WHEREAS**, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 67-3-28.2, assistance for local road construction and repair is available through the New Mexico Department of Transportation from the Local Government Road Improvement Fund (LGRF);

**WHEREAS**, the County of Santa Fe applied for funding from the New Mexico Department of Transportation Local Government Road Improvement Fund (LGRF) for pavement rehabilitation/improvements on the roads designated on Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference (the Project);

**WHEREAS**, the total project cost (including 25% county participation) is \$144,501.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Santa Fe has agreed with the State of New Mexico to utilize awarded funds from the LGRF for pavement rehabilitation/improvements of the roads designed on Exhibit A;

**WHEREAS**, to obtain funds from the Local Government Road Improvement Fund (LGRF) Program, a local government must agree to provide matching funds pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 67-3-32;

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County supports the Project and will provide 25% of the funds for the Project; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners agree to execute the Local Government Road Improvement Fund (LGRF) Program Cooperative Project Agreement to obtain funds for Pavement Rehabilitation/Improvements of Various County Roads in Santa Fe County, New Mexico as designated on Exhibit A; and Supports the Pavement Rehabilitation/Improvements of Various County Roads in Santa Fe County, New Mexico, and will provide matching funds for this Project in the amount of \$36,125.00

Location: Various County Roads, Santa Fe County, New Mexico  
Starting termini and Ending termini are as follows:

CR 46 (Ellis Ranch Road) beginning termini; Old Las Vegas Highway and ending termini; 0.40 mi to Dead End.

(Rancho Alegre Road) beginning termini; CR 45 and ending termini; 1.13 South of CR 45.

CR 60 (Nine Mile Road) beginning termini; 0.34 mi. from Old Las Vegas Highway and ending termini; 2.01 mi to Dead End.

CR Camino Montoya beginning termini; CR 56 and ending termini; Calle Debra.

CR 67J (Double Arrow Road) beginning termini; CR 67 and ending termini; Camino Quien Sabe.

CR 55 (Goldmine Road) beginning termini; SR 14 and ending termini; 1.36 mi. to Gate.

Scope of Work: Pavement Rehabilitation/Improvements of Various County Roads
