Ordinance No. 2009-4

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2008-5 TO REVISE
THE POJOAQUE VALLEY TRADITIONAL COMMUNITY DISTRICT
BOUNDARY AND IDENTIFY ADDITIONAL PROPERTIES WITHIN THE
MIXED-USE SUB-DISTRICT OF THE PVTC DISTRICT.**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2008-5 was approved in May of 2008 with a PVTC District boundary map and legal description that provided the best available information to determine an accurate boundary of privately owned parcels in the Traditional Communities of the Pojoaque Valley;

WHEREAS, several parcels were identified as part of the legal description of the PVTC District boundary, but were not indicated on the PVTC District Ordinance boundary map;

WHEREAS, the parcels of land proposed for inclusion into the Mixed-Use Zoning Sub-District have been determined appropriate for inclusion because:

- a) Currently there is an integration of uses, including commercial uses in these areas
- b) The parcels located in non-residential areas will likely be contiguous to existing and future commercial uses under Pojoaque Pueblo jurisdiction.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SANTA FE COUNTY THAT ORDINANCE No. 2004-1 OF THE SANTA FE COUNTY LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE IS HEREBY AMENDED, AS FOLLOWS:

Additional language to the PVTC District Ordinance in the Mixed-Use Zoning Sub-District section 12.7.B should be amended to read:

- 3. The Mixed-Use Sub-District boundary in Pojoaque follows property lines of specific parcels east and west of U.S. 84-285 between NM 503 intersection and CR 109 (North Shining Sun Road).
 - a. Properties included in this Sub-District are those parcels with direct access to U.S. 84-285 from Old Pueblito Road, and the parcels located off the frontage road access on Grazing Elk Drive.
 - b. Also included are those parcels located east of the U.S. 84-285 frontage road adjacent to Camino Trujillo.
 - c. Also included are two properties located on the west side of U.S. 84-285 frontage road between Gutierrez Street and Viarrial Street stoplights.
- 4. The Mixed-Use Sub-District boundary in Cuyamungue is located off the frontage road on the west and east side of U.S. 84-285 in the northern area of Cuyamungue.

1 As of the effective date of this Ordinance, the boundary and the Mixed-Use Zoning Sub-Districts
2 of the Pojoaque Valley Traditional Community District is amended as set forth on the map
3 attached hereto as **Attachment A**.


