4 CREATING A ROAD ADVISORY COMMITTEE; ESTABLISHING GEOGRAPHICAL
5 AREAS OF REPRESENTATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF CITIZEN INPUT FROM
6 ALL COMMUNITIES WITHIN SANTA FE COUNTY.

8 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SANTA
9 FE COUNTY:

10 Section 1. PURPOSE.--The purpose of this ordinance is to
11 identify and plan road improvement projects for Santa Fe
12 County, by establishing a mechanism whereby citizen input is
13 allowed and concerns are addressed.

15 Section 2. COMMITTEE CREATED--MEMBERSHIP--APPOINTMENT--
16 TERMS.-- There is created a Road Advisory Committee. The
17 committee shall be composed of fifteen (15) members, one from
18 each geographical area of the county as enumerated in Exhibit
19 "A". Members shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure
20 of the Board of County Commissioners for terms of three
21 years, staggered so that the terms of five (5) members
22 expires December 31 of each year or until their successors
23 have been duly appointed and qualified. In making the
24 initial appointments after the adoption of this ordinance,
25 five (5) members shall be appointed for terms expiring on

1 December 31, 1989; five (5) members for terms expiring on
2 December 31, 1990 and five (5) members for terms expiring on
3 December 31, 1991. A Chairman shall be selected by the
4 committee in January of each year. Once elected, the
5 Chairman shall serve for a term ending on December 31 of the
6 same year. The Committee may select such other officers as
7 it deems appropriate.

8 Section 3. VACANCIES.--A vacancy shall exist upon the
9 death, removal, resignation, or change of residence from the
10 geographical area represented by the member. Vacancies on
11 the committee shall be filled by the Board of County
12 Commissioners for the unexpired term of the member creating
13 the vacancy, and shall be from the same geographical area as
14 the member who created the vacancy.

16 Section 4. DUTIES OF THE COMMITTEE.-- The committee
17 shall:

- 18 1. review and recommend road improvements to the
19 Board of County Commissioners;
- 20 2. review and monitor road improvement projects;
- 21 3. research funding sources in order to establish
22 long-range planning for road improvements;
- 23 4. serve as liaison between the Board of County
24 Commissioners and the general public;

1 5. develop and recommend construction standards
2 for existing county roads;

3 6. meet at least once a month at a regularly
4 scheduled time and place, giving proper notice of each
5 meeting.

6 Section 5. ALTERNATE MEMBERS -- QUORUM -- A quorum of
7 the committee shall be eight members. A quorum is required to
8 exercise the powers granted herein. In order to maintain a
9 quorum at all meetings, the Board shall appoint an alternate
10 for each member to serve in their place with all rights and
11 privileges , including matters submitted to the committee for
12 consideration. Alternates shall be appointed by and
13 serve the same terms, and be from the same geographical area
14 as the member for whom they are representing on the
15 committee.

17 Section 6. This ordinance shall be effective thirty
18 (30) days after it is adopted and filed in the office of the
19 Santa Fe County Clerk.
