RESOLUTION NO. 2008 - 70

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A PORTION OF EAST PINE FOR COUNTY MAINTENANCE

Whereas, Santa Fe County encompasses a geographical area of approximately 2,000 square miles; and

Whereas, Santa Fe County is primarily rural with small areas of concentrated development; and

Whereas, a comprehensive road system is a necessary and vital link between communities; and

Whereas, there are an estimated 1,500 total miles of roads within Santa Fe County; and

Whereas, of the total miles, approximately 575 miles are recognized as County Roads and maintained by the County of Santa Fe (the "County"); and

Whereas, the County's goal is to provide the best services possible to Santa Fe County residents, within the available resources; and

Whereas, East Pine is located within Santa Fe County; and

Whereas, the first 0.64 miles of East Pine is maintained by the County; and

Whereas, the residents of the Silverado Subdivision have asked the County to accept and provide maintenance on a portion of East Pine, Exhibit "A"; and

Whereas, the County has the authority and capability to accept this road for maintenance; and

Whereas, the residents of the Silverado Subdivision have met all the requirements in the Road Acceptance Policy, Resolution 1998-119; and

Whereas, the County conducted an inspection of this road and determined that East Pine does not meet County standards; and

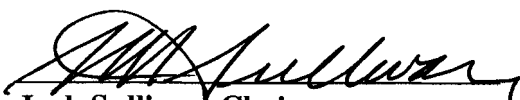
Whereas, the residents of the Silverado Subdivision have acquired legislative appropriations in the amount of \$30,000 for drainage and paving improvements to bring the road up to County standards; and

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Santa Fe ("BCC") finds it to be in the best interest of the residents of Santa Fe County to accept a portion of East Pine.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the BCC accepts for County maintenance the portion of East Pine, a dirt road, beginning at the intersection with Spruce and ending at the intersection with Pinon North/South, a distance of 0.30 miles, subject to the following conditions:

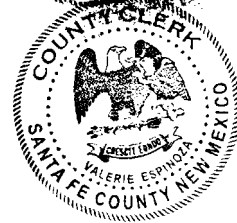
Santa Fe County does not accept any maintenance responsibility for residential driveways or drainage structures on driveways. It is advisable that residents repair damaged culverts and reinstall culverts to the proper flow line elevation. In the event that improper installation or lack of maintenance of drainage structures causes damage to the County maintained road, the County reserves the right to collect damages for repair against the responsible party.

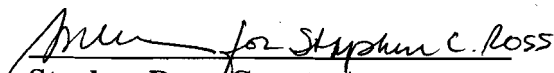
