A RESOLUTION FOR DONATION OF REGION III DRUG ENFORCEMENT TASK FORCE PERSONAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County desires to dispose of certain personal property identified in Exhibit A, attached; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit A details each item of personal property by department or office, equipment description, Santa Fe County property tag number, serial number, condition of equipment, and estimated fair market value; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department, City of Espanola, New Mexico, has requested the donation of furniture from Santa Fe County Region III Drug Enforcement Task Force to use in assisting its personnel in their job duties; and

WHEREAS, the requested furniture has an estimated current resale value of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or less and is unusable by the County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County that the Santa Fe County Region III Drug Enforcement Task Force shall, upon approval of the State Auditor, donate the personal property listed on Exhibit A pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 13-6-1 (2007).

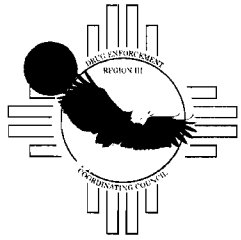

Please find attached our memo from New Mexico HIDTA granting Region III permission to dispose of our surplus equipment.

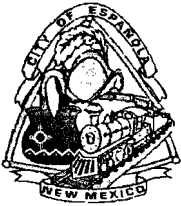

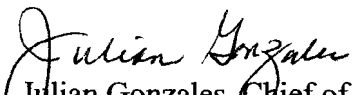
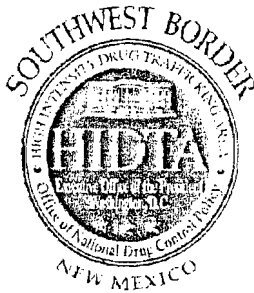
