A Resolution in Support of the Northern Rio Grande National Heritage Area


WHEREAS, Congress has recognized the combination of cultures, languages, arts, customs, architecture, and landscape of Santa Fe, Rio Arriba, and Taos counties as the Northern Rio Grande National Heritage Area; and

WHEREAS, Congress requires the Northern Rio Grande National Heritage Area, Inc. (herein after "NRGHA"), a non-profit corporation chartered in the State of New Mexico, to have its Board of Directors include representatives of the State of New Mexico; the counties of Santa Fe, Rio Arriba, and Taos; tribes and pueblos within the heritage area; the cities of Santa Fe, Espanola and Taos; and members of the general public; and

WHEREAS, Congress designated the NRGHA as responsible for creating a management plan that describes how the NRGHA will partner with communities and residents within the heritage area to accomplish the preservation and interpretation of the Heritage Area;

WHEREAS, the participation of the Santa Fe County Planning Department with NRGHA will provide vital input to the non-profit while the management plan, in turn, will provide goals and strategies for the Santa Fe County Planning Department's comprehensive Growth Management Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County hereby request the County Manager to designate a Santa Fe County representative to participate with NRGHA in the planning meetings and development of management plan.




