## RESOLUTION NO. 2017 - <u>52</u>

## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MANAGER TO SIGN AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION UNDER THE JUVENILE ADJUDICATION FUND GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, in 2009 the New Mexico State Legislature enacted NMSA 1978, Section 34-16-1, creating the "juvenile adjudication fund" to provide alternative procedures of adjudication for juvenile s charged with traffic offenses and other misdemeanors (collectively, "misdemeanors"); and

WHEREAS, money in the juvenile adjudication fund is appropriated to the New Mexico Department of Finance and Administration ("DFA") to administer the fund and to provide an alternative adjudication process for juveniles charged with misdemeanors; and

WHEREAS, DFA promulgated regulations, codified at 2.110.5 NMAC, to establish the juvenile adjudication fund grant program (the "Program") to help fund local alternative adjudication programs; and

**WHEREAS**, under Section 2.110.5.9(A) NMAC, counties are eligible to apply for grants under the Program; and

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County ("County") has a Teen Court Program that provides an alternative adjudication process for teens charged with misdemeanors; and

WHEREAS, the County's Teen Court alternative adjudication program includes the "components" required under 2.110.5 NMAC, including counseling, behavioral management, substance abuse prevention, youth development, mural development, shoplifting intervention, restorative justice, DWI prevention and media literacy programming; and

WHEREAS, the County can apply for a grant under the Program to help fund the County's Teen Court alternative adjudication program; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") understands that a minimum of ten percent (10%) of the proposed operating budget of the County's alternative adjudication program to be assisted under the Program must come from other non-state sources, and that "cash valued in-kind contributions may be used to meet this matching requirement." 2.110.5.10(A)(4) NMAC; and

WHEREAS, under Section 2.110.5.13(E) NMAC, an applicant for a grant under the Program must attach to its application a resolution from its governing body authorizing the application to be submitted to DFA.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board that the County Manager is hereby authorized to submit an application to DFA on behalf of the County to request grant funding in the amount of thirty five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00), pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 34-16-1 and 2.110.5 NMAC.
