## SANTA FE COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2017 - 60

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING STAFF TO SUBMIT A JOINT GRANT APPLICATION IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT TAOS FIELD OFFICE TO THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE RIVERS, TRAILS AND CONSERVATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM SEEKING ASSISTANCE IN DEVELOPING A CONCEPTUAL TRAIL PLAN ON THE BURNT CORN SPECIAL RECREATION MANAGEMENT AREA

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County has developed a master plan for Thornton Ranch Open Space which includes potential connections to the adjacent Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Burnt Corn Special Recreation Management Area (SRMA); and

WHEREAS, the BLM Taos Field Office has designated that the SRMA will "provide access to trails and open space, opportunities for routine exercise and escape and learning local history and prehistory"; and

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County and the BLM have been coordinating the management of the Thornton Ranch Open Space and the SRMA; and

WHEREAS, the BLM and Santa Fe County have drafted a joint application for submission to the National Park Service Rivers, Trails and Conservation Assistance Program seeking assistance with the development of a conceptual trail plan for the SRMA.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Santa Fe County Board of Commissioners authorizes staff to complete and submit a joint application with BLM for assistance from the National Park Service Rivers, Trails and Conservation Assistance Program in developing a conceptual trail plan for the SRMA.
- 2. The Santa Fe County Manager, or a designee, is authorized to sign all documents required to complete the application process, to submit additional information as may be required to complete the application process.




