**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF  
FIXED ASSETS WORTH MORE THAN \$5,000  
IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE STATUTE**

---

**WHEREAS**, Santa Fe County ("County") desires to dispose of certain personal property identified in Exhibit A, attached; and

**WHEREAS**, Exhibit A describes each item of personal property by department, tag number, description of fixed asset, and serial number, and also reflects the confirmation of the donation by the County and the City of Las Vegas, New Mexico; and

**WHEREAS**, the County desires to donate the personal property to the City of Las Vegas, New Mexico; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") hereby determines that (i) each item of personal property on Exhibit A has an estimated current resale value of more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board as follows:

1. The Board approves of the donation of the personal property on Exhibit A in accordance with NMSA 1978, Section 13-6-2; and
2. The Board directs that, to the extent feasible, the personal property shall be donated to the City of Las Vegas, New Mexico but if that is not feasible, it shall be disposed of as otherwise allowed by law.

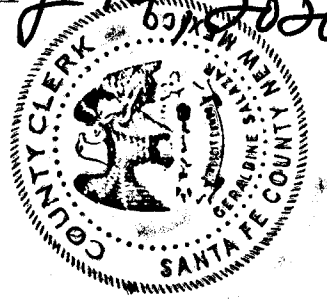

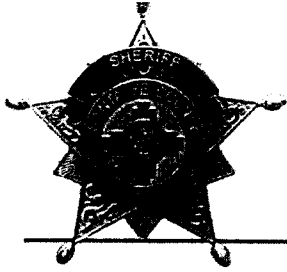


