A RESOLUTION

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2019-96, AS AMENDED BY RESOLUTION 2020-36, TO DESIGNATE A NEW POLLING PLACE/VOTER CONVENIENCE CENTER FOR CONSOLIDATED PRECINCTS 14, 72, 88, 114, 126, AND 150

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2019, the Santa Fe County (County) Board of County Commissioners (Board) adopted Resolution No. 2019-96, which (1) designated polling places in each precinct in the County for 2020 and 2021, (2) consolidated precincts, and (3) divided or adjusted boundaries of certain precincts pursuant to NMSA 1978, Sections 1-3-1, 1-3-4 and 1-3-5; and

WHEREAS, on May 5, 2020, the Board adopted Resolution No. 2020-36, which amended Resolution No. 2019-96 to (1) adjust certain precinct boundaries and (2) to designate a new polling place/voter convenience center; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 2019-96, as amended by Resolution No 2020-36, the Board designated "St. Joseph's Parish Hall, 2 E. Waldo Street," and "Turquoise Trail Charter Elementary School, 13 A San Marcos Loop," to serve as the polling place/voter convenience centers for consolidated Precincts 14, 72, 88, 114, 126, and 150; and

WHEREAS, the County Clerk's Office has been informed that St. Joseph's Parish Hall is no longer available to serve as a polling place/voter convenience center for the 2021 Regular Local Election to be held on November 2, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County has agreed to allow the County Clerk to utilize the Madrid Fire Station # 1, 5 Firehouse LN, Madrid, NM, as a polling place/voter convenience center for consolidated Precincts 14, 72, 88, 114, 126, and 150; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the Turquoise Trail Charter Elementary School, the Madrid Fire Station #1 is the most convenient and suitable public building in the precinct that can be obtained for use as a polling place/voter convenience center; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 1-3-5(B), no precinct shall be created, divided, abolished or combined or the boundaries adjusted less than four months prior to a statewide election, except by order of the district court; and

WHEREAS, contingent upon District Court approval, the Board wishes to amend Resolution No. 2019-96, as amended by Resolution No. 2020-36, in order to replace St. Joseph's Parish Hall, 2 E. Waldo Street, with Madrid Fire Station # 1, 5 Firehouse LN, Madrid, NM, as a polling place/voter convenience centers for consolidated Precincts 14, 72, 88, 114, 126, and 150.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, contingent upon District Court approval, the Board amends Resolution No. 2019-96, as amended by Resolution No. 2020-36, as follows:

- 1. Section 3 of Resolution No. 2019-96 is amended by replacing "St. Joseph's Parish Hall, 2 E. Waldo Street" with "Madrid Fire Station # 1, 5 Firehouse LN, Madrid, NM" as a Polling Place/Voter Convenience Center for consolidated Precincts 14, 72, 88, 114, 126, and 150.
- 2. The designation of Turquoise Trail Charter Elementary School, 13 A San Marcos Loop, as a Polling Place/Voter Convenience Center for consolidated Precincts 14, 72, 88, 114, 126, and 150 as set forth in Resolution No. 2019-96 shall remain in effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, following adoption of this Resolution by the Board, the County Attorney shall seek approval of the District Court of the new polling place/voter convenience center designation set forth above; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Clerk shall forward a copy of this Resolution to the Secretary of State and inform the Secretary of State when the District Court has approved the new polling place/voter convenience designation.
