**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF
FIXED ASSETS WORTH MORE THAN \$5,000
IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE STATUTE**

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County ("County") desires to dispose of certain personal property identified in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit A describes an item of personal property by department, tag number, description of fixed asset, and serial number; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to donate the item of personal property listed on Exhibit A to the Monticello Fire Department in Sierra County, NM; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") hereby determines that the item of personal property listed on Exhibit A has an estimated resale value of more than \$5,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board as follows:

1. The Board approves of the donation of the item of personal property listed on Exhibit A in accordance with NMSA 1978, Section 13-6-2 (2007); and
2. The Board directs that, to the extent feasible, the personal property shall be donated to the Monticello Fire Department in Sierra County, NM. If such donation is not feasible, the property shall be disposed of as allowed by law.
