Chief Black,

I was recently assigned to District Chief of Rowe VFD. I have been the District Chief for the Pecos Canyon Fire and Rescue District for the past 6 years and have made great accomplishments there as far as apparatus, equipment, membership and a class 5 ISO rating. In my new role as District Chief of Rowe VFD, my goal is similar to the accomplishments made in the Pecos Canyon District. An increase of water storage and apparatus is my first step in reaching these goals.

I have been speaking with Glorieta Pass District Chief Jane McSweeney about a 1991 Kodiak Tender (VIN 1GBM7H1M9MJ110577) that is available for donation from Santa Fe County Fire. Rowe VFD would gladly accept the tender as an addition to our fleet. We are need of a tender for increased water storage at Station 3 on Rowe Mesa. Being a rural development, there are no hydrants or drafting points in that section of the District. Response time for assisting tenders is approximately 40 to 45 minutes. The donated tender would increase the amount of available water and provide coverage until other tenders can arrive in the event of a structure or wildland fire.
