WHEREAS, Santa Fe County (“County”) desires to dispose of certain personal property identified in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit A describes items of personal property by department, tag number, description of fixed asset, and serial number; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to donate said items of personal property listed on Exhibit A to Vaughn Fire Department in Guadalupe County, New Mexico; and



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners that:

- 1) The Board approves of the donation of the item of personal property listed on Exhibit A in accordance with NMSA 1978, Section 13-6-2 (2007); and
- 2) The Board directs that, to the extent feasible, the personal property listed as G79017, 2010 Ford F550, VIN: 1FDAX5HR8AEA90174 shall be donated to the Vaughn Fire Department in Guadalupe County, New Mexico. If such donation is not feasible, the property shall be disposed of as allowed by law.







We are relied on by our surrounding communities as we are the closest Fire Department within decent reach. As all fire departments are extremely important and highly needed, Volunteer Fire Departments are limited to what we have access to. My goal is to have as many resources as possible readily available to my team to make their hard job somewhat easy.
