A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR LITTLE TESUQUE CREEK OPEN SPACE AND DIRECTING STAFF TO IMPLEMENT THE PLAN

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County owns and maintains a network of 6,750 acres of open space, 18 parks, and 65 miles of trails, including Little Tesuque Creek Open Space; and

WHEREAS, Little Tesuque Creek Open Space contains a popular day-use trail, as well as numerous important ecosystems including riparian forest, piñon-juniper woodland, ponderosa pine forest, and dry mixed-conifer forest; and

WHEREAS, the 2015 Sustainable Growth Management Plan and 2019 Open Space, Trails and Parks Strategic Management Plan call for developing individual management plans for open space properties; and

WHEREAS, the Little Tesuque Creek Open Space management plan outlines how Santa Fe County plans to manage this unique property for a variety of stakeholders and reflects Santa Fe County's desire to create an exceptional open space and trails system; and

WHEREAS, the management plan prioritizes projects for implementation in the short-term, mid-term and long-term, and identifies resources needed to implement these projects; and

WHEREAS, various stakeholders reviewed the management plan, including the Santa Fe Conservation Trust, which holds a conservation easement on a portion of the property; the Tesuque Valley Community Association; Northern New Mexico Master Naturalists; and the County Open Lands, Trails and Parks Advisory Committee (COLTPAC).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners that:

- 1. The management plan attached hereto as Exhibit A is hereby adopted;
- 2. Staff is directed to implement the management plan to the extent possible with available resources and to request amendments to the plan as needed;
- 3. Staff is directed to request necessary budget for staffing, training, planning, maintenance, and capital funding, as needed, for implementation of the management plan;
- 4. Staff is directed to involve community members and the public in the outlined management projects and activities contained within the management plan when appropriate.
