RESOLUTION NO. 2025 - 080

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE COUNTY MANAGER AUTHORITY TO NEGOTIATE THE PURCHASE AND ACQUISITION OF OFFICE SPACE IN SANTA FE, NM, TO SUPPORT THE FUNCTIONS OF THE COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT REGIONAL YOUTH BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CENTER

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County desires to purchase real property consisting of 3.48 acres of real property, and located on that property is a 33,214 square foot building consisting of office space located at 2935 Rodeo Park Drive E, Santa Fe, New Mexico ("Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Property has been appraised by an MAI certified and New Mexico licensed Appraiser to determine the Fair Market Value of the property; and

WHEREAS, the Property is intended to house the Santa Fe County Regional Youth Behavioral Health Center, a program bringing together a comprehensive continuum of care of providers; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 Youth Risk and Resiliency Survey ("YRRS") reports that 30% of high school students in Santa Fe County felt sad or hopeless for two or more consecutive weeks, highlighting a concerning trend in youth mental health; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 YRRS also found that 25.6% of Santa Fe County high school students experienced symptoms of anxiety, indicating widespread emotional distress among adolescents; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 YRRS further revealed that 22.5% of Santa Fe County middle school students seriously considered suicide, emphasizing the urgent need for accessible, effective mental health resources and prevention programs for local youth; and

WHEREAS, currently, Santa Fe and the surrounding area lacks a dedicated, youth-centered behavioral health facility that provides a comprehensive range of walk-in or low-barrier mental health services specifically designed to address the unique and diverse needs of youth and their families; and

WHEREAS, a youth behavioral health center in Santa Fe County would address significant gaps in care by providing accessible services, including individual and family therapy, grief support, crisis response, psychiatric care, suicide prevention, intervention and postvention, as well as additional behavioral health supports identified by youth, families, and service providers; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners acknowledges the importance of addressing this community need; and

WHEREAS, the landowner, the National Center for Genome Research, would like to sell Property to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Property would be purchased by the County to establish the Santa Fe County Regional Youth Behavioral Health Center; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board as follows:

- 1. The Board delegates to the County Manager the authority to negotiate to purchase real property as described in the Resolution on behalf of Santa Fe County.
- 2. The Board further delegates authority to the County Manager authority to negotiate and execute the Purchase Agreement and any other documents necessary or proper for the purchase of the real property; provided, however, that the consideration paid by the County is contingent upon appraisal, shall be no more than the fair market value of the real property as determined by an appraisal report prepared by a New Mexico licensed appraiser.
