**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING PROJECTS FOR INCLUSION IN SANTA FE
COUNTY'S INFRASTRUCTURE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN (ICIP) FOR
FISCAL YEARS 2027-2031; AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF PLAN TO THE NEW
MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION (DFA); AND
REPLACING RESOLUTION 2025-080**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") of Santa Fe County recognizes that the financing of public capital projects is an important aspect of local government; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to access multiple financing mechanisms in order to maximize capital resources; and

WHEREAS, capital improvements planning is an effective tool to help prioritize projects that should be developed and identify concrete actions and strategies to achieve project development; and

WHEREAS, short- and long-range capital planning contributes to local and regional efforts to identify and select projects; and

WHEREAS, a list of projects for inclusion in the County's Infrastructure and Capital Improvements Plan (ICIP) for Fiscal Years (FY) 2027-2031 was developed in a series of meetings among citizens, staff, and elected officials from various levels of government; and

WHEREAS, the Board reviewed the list of potential projects at its meetings on June 24, 2025 and July 8, 2025; and

WHEREAS, that list of projects was adopted by the Board through Resolution 2025-080 in July of 2025; and

WHEREAS, that list of projects should be updated to incorporate revisions to the prior list based on the guidance provided in the September 3, 2025 Governor Lujan-Grisham memo and presented at the meeting on November 10, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners that:

1. The Board hereby adopts as Santa Fe County's FY 2027-2031 ICIP the list of projects that staff presented to the Board at its November 10, 2025 meeting. The list of projects is attached as Exhibit A.

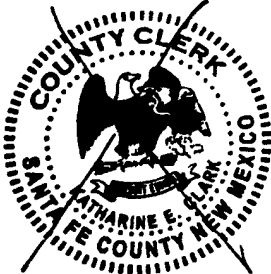

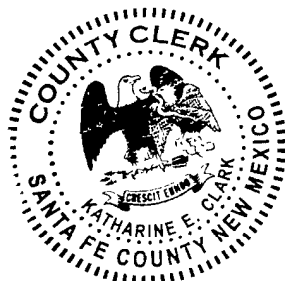
