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**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE DISPOSITION OF FIXED ASSETS WORTH  
LESS THAN \$30,000 IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE STATUTE**

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**WHEREAS**, Santa Fe County (“County”) desires to dispose of certain tangible personal property identified in Exhibit A; and

**WHEREAS**, Exhibit A describes an item of tangible personal property by department, tag number, description of fixed asset, vehicle identification number, reason for surplus, condition of fixed asset, and estimated value; and

**WHEREAS**, the County desires to donate the item of tangible personal property listed <sup>to</sup> ~~in~~ Exhibit A to the Cabo Lucero Fire Department in San Miguel County, New Mexico; and <sup>in</sup> ~~to~~

**WHEREAS**, NMSA 1978, Section 13-6-1 (2025) governs the disposition of tangible personal property belonging to a local public body that is (1) of a current resale value of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) or less; and (2) worn out, unusable or obsolete to the extent that the item is no longer economical or safe for continued use by the body; and ~~CHIEF

**WHEREAS**, NMSA 1978, Section 13-6-1 (D) allows a local public body, like the County, to donate to another local public body, like Cabo Lucero Fire Department in San Miguel County, New Mexico tangible personal property meeting the above-mentioned criteria; and ~~to~~

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners (“Board”) hereby determines that the item of tangible personal property listed on Exhibit A (1) has an estimated resale value of \$30,000.00 or less and (2) is worn out, unusable or obsolete to the extent that the item is no longer economical or safe for continued use by the County. ~~1/3/2015~~

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners hereby:

1. Approves of the disposal of tangible personal property listed on Exhibit A in accordance with NMSA 1978, Section 13-6-1 ; and
2. Directs that, to the extent feasible, the tangible personal property listed as G-46920, 2001 Freight Liner, VIN#: 1FV6JLCBX1HG62751 shall be donated to the Cabo Lucero Fire Department, in San Miguel County, New Mexico. If such donation is not feasible, the property shall be disposed of as allowed by law.




