RESOLUTION NO. 2026 - 008

**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE DISPOSITION OF FIXED ASSETS WORTH
LESS THAN \$30,000 IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE STATUTE**

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County (“County”) desires to dispose of certain tangible personal property identified in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit A describes an item of tangible personal property by department, tag number, description of fixed asset, vehicle identification number, reason for surplus, condition of fixed asset, and estimated value; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to donate the item of tangible personal property listed in Exhibit A to the Newkirk Fire Department in Guadalupe County, New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 13-6-1 (2025) governs the disposition of tangible personal property belonging to a local public body that is (1) of a current resale value of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) or less; and (2) worn out, unusable or obsolete to the extent that the item is no longer economical or safe for continued use by the body; and

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 13-6-1 (D) allows a local public body, like the County, to donate to another local public body, like Newkirk Fire Department in Guadalupe County, New Mexico, tangible personal property meeting the above-mentioned criteria; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (“Board”) hereby determines that the item of tangible personal property listed on Exhibit A (1) has an estimated resale value of \$30,000.00 or less and (2) is worn out, unusable or obsolete to the extent that the item is no longer economical or safe for continued use by the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners hereby:

1. Approves of the disposal of tangible personal property listed on Exhibit A in accordance with NMSA 1978, Section 13-6-1; and
2. Directs that, to the extent feasible, the tangible personal property listed as G-42893, 2000 Freight Liner, VIN#: 1FV6JLCB9YHF59329 shall be donated to the Newkirk Fire Department in Guadalupe County, New Mexico. If such donation is not feasible, the property shall be disposed of as allowed by law.

I have been working diligently to increase recruitment and to get all members properly trained. My next step is to increase our water resources and apparatus support.


