RESOLUTION NO. 2026 - 081

**A RESOLUTION TO DELEGATE TO THE COUNTY MANAGER THE AUTHORITY
TO NEGOTIATE FOR WORKERS' COMPENSATION, AUTO PHYSICAL DAMAGE
AND PROPERTY COVERAGES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027 AND TO EXECUTE
PURCHASE ORDERS, AGREEMENTS, AND OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY OR
ADVISABLE TO EFFECTUATE SUCH COVERAGE**

WHEREAS, Santa Fe County (County), through its broker, HUB International Services, Inc. (HUB), evaluated proposals for workers' compensation coverage, auto physical damage coverage, and property coverage for the Fiscal Year 2027 (i.e. July 1, 2026 – June 30, 2027); and

WHEREAS, HUB evaluated ten options for workers' compensation coverage, five options for both auto physical damage and property from the New Mexico County Insurance Authority (NMCIA); and

WHEREAS, HUB has evaluated the proposed options for workers' compensation coverage and has indicated that the most advantageous proposal for the County is NMCIA's option of a \$100,000 deductible option for workers' compensation at a premium of \$453,782 and expected retentions of \$465,556 for an expected total cost of \$919,338; and

WHEREAS, HUB has evaluated the proposed auto physical damage options and has indicated that the most advantageous proposal for the County is NMCIA's option of a \$50,000 deductible option at a premium of \$81,407 and expected retentions of \$75,873 for an expected total cost of \$157,280; and

WHEREAS, HUB has evaluated the proposed options for property coverage and has indicated that the most advantageous proposal for the County is NMCIA's option of a \$100,000 deductible option at a premium of \$603,930 and expected retentions of \$122,011 for an expected total cost of \$725,941; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) of the County has determined that NMCIA's options of a \$100,000 deductible option at a premium of \$453,782 and expected retentions of \$465,556 for an expected total cost of \$919,338 for workers' compensation coverage; a \$50,000 deductible option at a premium of \$81,407 and expected retentions of \$75,873 for an expected total cost of \$157,280 for auto physical damage coverage; and a \$100,000 deductible option at a premium of \$603,930 and expected retentions of \$122,011 for an expected total cost of \$725,941 for property coverage for the County; and

WHEREAS, the proposed contributions for NMCIA workers' compensation, auto physical damage and property coverage exceeds the County Manager's general signature authority; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to authorize the County Manager to negotiate with NMCIA for workers' compensation, auto physical damage and property coverage for Fiscal Year 2027 and to execute on behalf of the County all purchase orders, agreements, and other documents

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necessary or advisable to effectuate such coverage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners hereby delegates to the County Manager the authority to:

1. Negotiate with NMCIA for workers' compensation, auto physical damage and property coverage for Fiscal Year 2027; and
2. Execute, on behalf of the County, purchase orders, agreements, and other documents necessary or proper to effectuate such coverage.

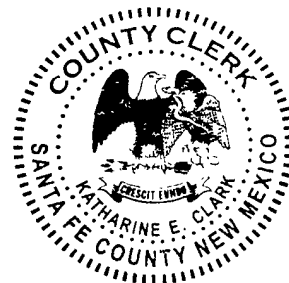
