# A RESOLUTION ADOPTING LOCAL GOVERNMENTS ROAD FUND PROJECT NO. CAP-5-19(470) FOR PAVEMENT REHABILITATION/IMPROVEMENTS OF COUNTY ROADS THROUGHOUT SANTA FE COUNTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 67-3-28.2 (Local governments road fund created; uses), assistance for local road construction and repair is available through the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) from the Local Governments Road Fund (LGRF); and

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Fe (County) applied for fiscal year 2019 LGRF funding for pavement rehabilitation/improvements on various roads within the County; and

WHEREAS, by letter dated June 4, 2018 (see Exhibit A), NMDOT informed the County that Project No. CAP-5-19(470) (the Project) is approved; and

WHEREAS, prior to development of a Cooperative Agreement for the Project, NMDOT requires the Santa Fe Board of County Commissioners (BCC) to adopt a resolution adopting the Project and verifying its priority status; and

WHEREAS, the location and other information concerning the Project is depicted on the attached maps (see Exhibit B) and in the following table:
